Scholarship

At JVBI (DU), scholarship is offered on tuition fee, for the subsequent semester also, only if the student maintain equivalent academic performance as per the University standards.

Further, the University confers merit based scholarships subject to the terms and conditions, listed by the University, such as, regularity in attendance, progress, good character and social conduct.

Jain Vishva Bharti Institute offers following scholarships for the international students:

- JAIN VISHVA BHARTI INSTITUTE (Deemed University) offers up to 50% scholarship on tuition fee to international students, which is further based on performance in the qualifying examinations.
- Students, wishing to avail the MERIT scholarship must send their transcripts/ certificates to jvbidun@gmail.com for verification and calculation of scholarships.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- Grant of scholarships is subject to verification of original transcripts, certificates and other documents required by the University at the time of reporting at the University.
- If an applicant is eligible for Scholarship scheme along with any other scheme offering monetary benefit under any policy of JVBI, then he/she must opt for only one scheme of his/her choice.
- If a student earlier admitted for a programme under scholarship scheme, opts for a change of programme, then, scholarship benefits will be according to the new programme chosen.
- Scholarship will be applicable on Tuition fee (per semester) for standard duration of the programme.
- Scholarship will not cover any other fee component / facilities like Backlog / re-appear fee etc.
- Scholarship is not applicable on Hostel/Residential fee
- Scholarship is not applicable for 1 year Diploma Programmes

How to Apply (Application Process)

Step-1 : Complete the application form

- The application form can be downloaded from the University Website (https://jvbi.ac.in/pdf/admission/JVBI_Admission_Application_Form.pdf)
- Email the duly filled-in application form to jvbiadnun@gmail.com along with all necessary documents.

Documents required for processing the application:

(a) Passport Size Photo

(b) Documents in PDF

- (i) Mark sheet (10th /Secondary) - ('O' Level)
- (ii) Mark sheet (12th/Senior Secondary) - ('A' Level)
- (iii) Graduation Mark Sheets (All semesters) and passing certificates/ degree (PG Admissions)
- (iv) Attested Photocopy - Passport and National ID Card
- (v) Transfer/Migration Certificates (if any)
- (vi) Equivalent Certificate from AIU (Association of Indian University), supporting qualifications

Note: Transcripts in languages other than English are not acceptable.

Step- 2 Issuance of Offer Letter after Eligibility Check

Students meeting the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the Admission Prospectus will be considered.

Step 4- Offer of Admission

Provisional admission letter and Visa letter will be issued once the payment will be received. You must deposit the full fee to confirm admission. After obtaining the Provisional admission and Visa letter, you can apply for a visa.

Step 5- Completion of Admission

- On arrival, students must submit their original documents to the Registrar's office for verification and to confirm the admission.
- The student is required to report one week before commencement of the programme to complete all admission formalities and for orientation program.
- Once your travel plans are made, email us your
 - Flight details
 - Arrival date and time
 - Contact us by email or phone to confirm we have received your arrival information.
- International Students will be guided with directions, and our Office for International Affairs will remain in touch with you for further assistance.
- All Foreign/NRI students must register themselves with the concerned District Foreigners Registration Office/Foreigners Regional Registration Office within 14 days of their first arrival in India.

Note:

- Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.
- The last dates for acceptance of application forms for each of the programme is shown in Academic Calendar.
- The Application Fee once paid is non-refundable and no further correspondence in this regards will be entertained.

Fee Details Programme wise to be shared in USD (as per prospectus)

Eligibility Criteria for Admission

- For admission to *Undergraduate courses*, candidates must have completed 12 years of schooling (equivalent to the 10+2 system of Indian duration) with a minimum 50% score.
- For admission to Postgraduate courses, candidates must have completed Bachelors degree from a recognized University, with a minimum of 50% in the relevant subjects.
- For PhD programs a Masters degree in the relevant field is necessary.
- The Diploma courses are for students who want to pursue short-term regular courses. The minimum requirement for taking up such courses is either 10 or 10+2 years of regular schooling.
- All foreign students are required to submit the Equivalence certificate from AIU (Association of Indian University) in support of their qualifications.

AIU Certificate:

Association of Indian Universities (AIU) issues an equivalence certificate to International students with foreign qualifications to facilitate their admission in Indian Universities.

VISA & FRRRO

Visas

- International students who wish to study in India must obtain a Student Visa before travelling to India.
- Please make enquiries at the Indian Consulate/Embassy /High Commission in your country of application to ascertain the correct procedure and time necessary to obtain a visa valid for the term of study of your program at JAIN VISHVA BHARATI INSTITUTE (Deemed to be University).

Extension of Visas

- Foreign students may approach the concerned FRRROs/District Superintendent of Police (FROs) for extension of stay for a period of one year at a time up to the duration of the course or 5 years whichever is less for students pursuing full time and regular course.
- The FRRROs / FROs cum Superintendent of Police can grant one year Visa extension to students and research scholar desirous to come to study on year to year basis for a period of up to five years subject to due sponsorship by the Institution and nothing adverse against the foreigner.
- The following documents are required to be submitted at the time of Visa Extension as per the immigration rules in India:
 - Visa Extension form for extended stay in India
 - 1 Recent passport size photograph
 - Bonafide certificate from College / University / Institute (In original)
 - Copy of passport / VISA / Registration Book
 - Copy of valid and notarized Lease/Rent agreement OR Copy of C-Form from the Hotel OR copy of recent electricity/telephone bill along with the letter from the landlord, towards proof of residence.

Registration

- All international students are required by law to register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRRO)/ local police authorities as per regulation of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India. At present, this must be within 14 days of arrival in India but please check this information with the Consulate/Embassy/High Commission in your country before departure as these rules are subject to change.
- Students must comply with visa rules and registration requirements and keep abreast of any changes.
- Accordingly, students are responsible for ensuring that their visas are valid throughout the period of study at JVBI and for maintaining their registration with the FRRRO/local police.

PRE-ARRIVAL ESSENTIALS

International students planning to join Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed-to-be University) should ensure the following before departure from their home country:

Essential Pre-Departure Checklist

- Travel & Visa
 - Book your flight to Indira Gandhi International Airport (Delhi) only after receiving a Valid Student Visa from the Indian Embassy or High Commission in your country.

- JVBI, Ladnun is approximately 400 KM from Delhi and can be reached by rail or road (approx. 6-8 hours journey).
- Vaccination & Health
 - Ensure you have taken all required vaccinations, including Yellow Fever (if applicable), Typhoid, Hepatitis A & B, and COVID-19 (if required by Indian authorities).
 - Obtain a medical fitness certificate as per international travel norms.
 - It is advisable to carry any prescribed medications with a doctor's note.
- Arrival Assistance
 - Inform the Office for International Affairs at JVBI at least two weeks before arrival for travel guidance and coordination.
 - While airport pickup facility is available, however you will be guided with directions, and the International Student Cell will remain in touch with you for further assistance during your journey to Ladnun.
- Documents to Carry
 - Original Admission Letter issued by JVBI
 - Original academic certificates, degrees, and transcripts
 - At least 15 passport-sized photographs
 - Valid Passport and Visa
 - Any additional documents mentioned in your offer/admission letter
- Financial Essentials
 - Carry funds in the form of International Debit/Credit Cards or Forex/Travel Cards.
 - You may also carry some money in cash (INR) for immediate expenses; currency exchange is available at the airport and major cities.
- Luggage & Safety
 - Keep important documents and valuables in your cabin baggage.
 - Carry a photocopy and digital scan of all essential documents separately for safety.
 - Label your baggage clearly.
- Weather:
 - Summer (April–June): 30°C to 45°C
 - Winter (November–February): 5°C to 20°C
 - Bring season-appropriate clothing—especially woollens for winter.

- Electricity & Adaptors
 - India uses 230–240V, 50Hz. Plug types are C, D, and M (2-pin and 3-pin).
 - Bring a universal adapter if your devices use a different plug or voltage.
- Essentials for Initial Days
 - Although most necessities are available nearby (markets within 3–5 km), bring essentials for the first few days (medicines, toiletries, basic food items, etc.).
 - The university campus also has a tuck shop and local vendors.
- Emergency Contacts & Communication
 - Keep handy the contact details of the Office for International Affairs, embassy, and family.

HOSTEL/GUEST HOUSE ACCOMMODATION FEE

1. The Lodging boarding fee of non-air conditioned for foreign students will be \$3500 per annum, \$ 1800 for six months and \$1000 for three months.
2. The hostel accommodation fee of Air-Conditioned Room/Guest House for foreign students for all programme will be \$6000 for guest house for per annum, \$3500 for six months and \$ 2000 for three months.

POST-ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Once international students arrive in India, the following formalities and procedures must be followed to ensure a smooth transition to academic life at Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed-to-be University), Ladnun.

Airport & Customs Formalities

- Upon arrival at Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi, students must:
 - Declare baggage and currency as per Indian customs regulations.
 - Fill out a Currency Declaration Form (CDF) if carrying foreign currency above the prescribed limit.
 - Complete the Disembarkation (Arrival) Card, typically distributed during the flight.
- Customs Clearance Channels:
 - Green Channel: For passengers carrying no dutiable or high-value items.
 - Red Channel: For those with dutiable goods, high-value electronics, or unaccompanied baggage (must fill Tourist Baggage Re-export Form if applicable).

Travel to Ladnun & Support from JVBI

- If you have shared your arrival details with JVBI's Office for International Affairs in advance (minimum two weeks before), you will receive guidance for travel and arrival assistance.

- The university does not currently offer airport pickup, but full travel guidance and contact support will be provided.

Reporting at JVBI Campus

- Upon reaching the JVBI campus in Ladnun, international students must report to the Office for International Affairs without delay.
- Carry the following documents:
 - Passport and Student Visa
 - Original Admission Letter
 - Academic Certificates and Transcripts
 - Passport-sized Photographs
 - Medical Fitness Certificate
- You will be required to:
 - Fill out the registration form
 - Submit all required documents
 - Undergo document verification
 - Complete medical check-up and receive your medical insurance card

Important: Late reporting may lead to cancellation of admission. Students must report within the timeline mentioned in the Admission Letter.

Mandatory FRRRO Registration

- As per Indian government regulations, all international students (except citizens of Nepal and Bhutan) must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRRO) within 14 days of arrival in India.
- JVBI will assist and guide students throughout the FRRRO registration process.
- This may include:
 - HIV/AIDS Test (as per FRRRO requirement)
 - Residential permit form submission
 - Document upload and appointment scheduling via the e-FRRRO portal

Final Administrative Requirements at JVBI

After settling into accommodation, international students must:

- Complete registration with the Office for International Affairs
- Fulfill admission formalities as advised
- Attend medical examination, if prescribed
- Begin academic orientation and course registration

Timely completion of these steps is essential to avoid penalties, visa issues, or academic delay.

Student Welfare

The Department of Student Welfare at Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed-to-be University) is dedicated to nurturing a supportive, inclusive, and value-based campus environment that encourages the holistic development of every student.

How to Reach JVBI

While Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed-to-be University), Ladnun does not currently provide direct airport pickup, full travel assistance and guidance is offered to international students through the Office for International Affairs.

Students arriving in India are advised to plan their journey to JVBI carefully and follow the directions provided below:

Arrival in India

- Book your flight to:
Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL), New Delhi

- From Delhi, you can reach Ladnun (Rajasthan) by:
 - Train: Direct trains available from Delhi to Ladnun Junction (LDH)
 - Bus: RSRTC or Private Buses
 - Private taxi or app-based cab services (approx. 6-8 hours)

Travel Assistance Terms

- Airport pickup facility is not available; however, travel assistance is provided.
- Share your arrival details at least one week in advance with the Office for International Affairs.
- Students traveling in groups may coordinate transport through the University's help.
- If traveling individually, students must arrange transportation at their own cost.
- Inform JVBI at least 24 hours prior in case of flight rescheduling, delay, or cancellation.
- App-based taxis and rail bookings can be arranged with guidance from the University.
