Study in India – Step-by-Step Guide for International Students at JVBI

This step-by-step guide outlines the essential process for international students seeking admission to Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed-to-be University), Ladnun, Rajasthan, under the Government of India's Study in India initiative.

Please follow the steps below carefully to ensure a smooth application and transition to life in India.

Step 1: Register & Get Your SII ID

To begin, register on the official [Study in India Portal](#). During registration, provide your name, country, email ID, date of birth, and mobile number, and set a password.

You will be issued a unique SII ID—this ID is necessary to apply for admission at JVBI and to access all related processes including your dashboard, offer letters, visa status, and updates.

✦ This SII ID is required for all applicants seeking admission through the Study in India platform.

Step 2: Explore Programs Offered at JVBI

Once registered, use your SII ID to access the dashboard and browse the programs available at Jain Vishva Bharati Institute. JVBI offers a wide range of programs rooted in its academic heritage and global outlook.

Available fields include:

- Jainology and Comparative Religion Philosophy
- Nonviolence and Peace Studies
- Yoga and Science of Living
- Languages (Prakrit, Sanskrit, Hindi, Rajasthani, and English)
- Political Sciences, Humanities, and Education
- Naturopathy (BNYS)

Programs are available at Undergraduate, Postgraduate, Doctoral, and Certificate levels. You may express interest in multiple courses offered by JVBI that align with your academic and professional goals.

✦ There is no application fee to show interest through the portal.

Step 3: Submit Your Application to JVBI

Log in to your Student Dashboard using your SII ID and password to complete your application to JVBI.

The application includes:

1. Basic Information (as per passport)
2. Academic Details (educational qualifications, certificates)
3. Course Choice (select JVBI programs that suit your goals)

Upload all required documents, including:

- Passport copy
- Educational transcripts
- Photo and signature
- Any qualifying test scores (if applicable)

Once submitted, your application will be reviewed by JVBI for academic and program-specific eligibility.

✦ Keep checking your dashboard and email for updates or requests for additional documents.

Step 4: Receive and Review Offer Letter from JVBI

If selected, you will receive a formal Offer Letter from Jain Vishva Bharati Institute through the Study in India portal.

The offer letter will include:

- Name of the program and specialization
- Academic calendar and duration
- Tuition fee details
- Scholarship/waiver (if applicable)
- Deadline to accept the offer

You are advised to carefully read all terms and accept the offer within the given timeframe to confirm your admission.

✦ Multiple reminders may not be issued—please accept within the deadline.

Step 5: Apply for Student Visa / E-Visa

After accepting your offer and paying any initial fee (if required), proceed to apply for an Indian Student Visa through the [Indian Visa Portal](#).

You will need:

- Valid passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- JVBI admission letter
- Proof of fee payment

- Passport-size photos
- Proof of residence
- Personal bank statement

The visa allows legal entry for full-time study in India and is typically valid for the entire course duration.

Step 6: Register with E-FRRO (Immigration Authority in India)

Upon arrival in India, students holding a Student Visa must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO) within 14 days. This is mandatory as per Indian government regulations.

Use the online e-FRRO platform: <https://indianfrro.gov.in/frro>

Upload your:

- Passport and visa copies
- JVBI admission letter
- Local address in India
- Photographs
- Fee payment proof

The system is digital and does not require physical visits unless specially requested by authorities.

✦ JVBI's Office for International Affairs will guide you through the FRRO registration process and assist in fulfilling legal formalities.
