ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

ESTABLISHMENT OF JVB INSTITUTE

Jain VishvaBharati Institute (Deemed University) established in 1991 with the inspiration of 'GurudevTulsi'. This Institute is a solely an educational institution dedicated to cultivate and practice high Ideas of 'Anekant' including tolerance and peaceful co-existence for the weal of the mankind. This Institution is registered under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act 1958 vide Registration No. 43/ Nagaur/1991-92 dated 13.11.2007. Central Government vide Gazette Notification No. F-9-9/87-43 dated 20th March 1991 and F6-9/87CPP (Desk-C) dated 03.07.1991 issued by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India approved this Institution as Deemed University under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 and granted affiliation under section 12B of this Act. The Institution has been granted membership of Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The University has been accredited by NAAC as grade 'B+'. Directorate of Distance Education University Grant commission has also recognized the programmes offered in Open Distance Learning (ODL) by this Institute vide letter No. 6-3/2018 (DEB-III) dated 13 Nov. 2018.

THE CITY LADNUN

Rajasthan is a magical land set amidst the desolate desert beauty. It's sand is replete with aeshetic beauty and chivalric glory and is immensely rich in culture, history and natural beauty. Everything about Rajasthan fascinates from miles of golden stretches of sand to the kaleidoscope of magnificent forts, opulent palaces and marvelous havelies, each having a splendid architectural creation and a legend of its own. The cities of Rajasthan still retain the medieval flavour keeping alive the timeless traditions in the rich art and craft.

Ladnun, the city situated in Nagaur District is famous for Jain temples of exquisite marble work, old Dargah of Umarshah Peer and other ancient temples of pilgrimage and architectural importance and above all for Jain VishvaBharati Institute. It is the birth place of a great legendary and visionary Jain seer and saintAcharyaTulsi. The excursions from Ladnun within 40-45 kms are DungarBalaji, SalasarBalajiDham, TirupatiBalaji at Sujangarh and TaalChhapar. Ladnun is well connected by road from Delhi, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Bikaner, Ajmer and Ahmedabad and by rail from Delhi, Ratangarh, Jodhpur, Didwana, Degana.

THE CAMPUS

- **DIGITAL STUDIO:** Digital Studio is equiped with the latest technology, where the renowned scholars record (Audio Visual) their lectures.
- **MEDICAL CENTRE**: The Medical Consultancy services (Ayurvedic, Homeopathy, Naturopathy and Physiotherapy facility) are available on campus.
- **MEDITATION AND YOGA CENTRE**: Institute has the Centre for Yoga and Meditation with necessary equipments for development of balanced personality.
- **AUDITORIUM**: The Institute has a well-equipped state of art auditorium to foster the need of academic and cultural programmes of the institute.
- **GYMNASIUM**: The Institute has gymnasium with all necessary equipments along with music system. This facility is available for staff and students separately for male and female.

SPORTS FACILITIES: There are facilities of in-door and out-door games for the students and staff of the institute.

CANTEEN: The well equipedhygenic canteen is situated in Campus.

GUEST HOUSE :Institute has Guest House with matchless lodging and boarding facilities for the guests of Institute and parents of JVBI Students.

INFORMATION REGARDING DISTANCE EDUCATION

ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

- Duly filled-in application form along with one self attested photograph, copies of mark-sheets, certificates, one ID proof and a Demand Draft for the requisite fee should reach JVBI, Ladnun on or before the due dates mentioned in the Prospectus.
- The application forms received after the due date or found incomplete are liable to be rejected and no correspondence in this regard shall be made by the Institute. JVBI will not be lible for postal delay.
- After the scrutiny of the admission forms, the candidates will be enrolled by the Institute. Identity card will be sent to them.
- The applicants are advised to send their application forms by registered post only.
- If a candidate remains absent in the annual examination, he/she may be allowed to continue his/her studies in the same class in the very next subsequent year only with latest syllabus prescribed. For this he/she will have to pay Rs. 2000/- for renewal.

STUDY MATERIAL AND SESSIONAL WORK

• After the enrolment, the study materials will be dispatched to the students by post or they can also collect from JVBI, Ladnun. A set of 15 questions of Assignment for each subject/paper is available on the Institute website (www.jvbi.ac.in) from which the students of UG and PG can select any three questions of each subject/paper. Marks obtained in these sessional works will be added to the marks obtained in the subject/paper concerned in the annual examination. The last date of submitting Assignments will be 31 March, 2020.

CONTACT CLASSES

A. Practical-cum-Contact Classes for M.A. in Yoga and Science of Living:

- Every student will have to participate in practical-cum-contact classes for 120 hours to be organised at different centres in Rajasthan. (list will be displayed on the institute website: www.jvbi.ac.in/dde).
- For attending the contact classes the candidates have to bear the expenses of boarding and Lodging. During this period the students will be assigned practical work and also to solve their difficulties related to theory part to all possible extent.

B. Contact Classes for Other Courses:

- Contact classes for B.A., B.Com.and M.A. will be conducted for ten days on different centres in Rajasthan.
- For the students of B.A. offering Science of Living as one of the optional subjects, the practical training will also be given during contact classes.

COMMON RULES FOR ALL THE CONTACT CLASSES

- All the students are required to attend the contact classes.
- The examination of practical papers will be conducted at the end of contact classes.
- The marks so awarded will be added to those obtained in the annual examination.
- The students who do not attend the Practical-cum-contact classes followed by practical examination, will not be allowed to appear in annual examination.

Note: (i) 50% concession in Tuition fee in the Regular Course and 50% concession in Programe fee in the Corrospondence Course shall be granted to the spouse and two dependent children of the staff members of the JVBI. No concession will be given to staff member for his/her own study.

- (ii) 25% concession in Tuition fee in the Regular Course and 25% concession in Programe fee in the Corrospondence Course shall be granted to the spouse and two dependent children of the staff members of JVB.
- (iii) Sadhus/Sadhvis/Saman/Samanis/Mumukshu etc., who have renounced the worldly possessions are exempted from paying any kind of fee.
- (iv) In the event of a student/candidate found ineligible or withdrawing before the starting of the course, the waiting list candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (one thousand only) shall be refunded to the student/candidate. In case a student leaves

- after joining the course and the seat consequently falling vacant is filled by another candidate by the last date fixed for admission, the fee collected from the earlier candidate will be refunded accordingly.
- (v) The commencement of any regular course or any subject or any paper of the course is subject to the enrolment of a minimum number of students. If the admission in a particular course/subject in less than 5 in PG and 10 in UG; the said course/subject will not be continued except 2 in the course of Prakrit and 5 in the case of Sanskrit. The decision of the competent authority will be final.
- (vi)The Institute reserves the right to revise the fees, etc., from time to time.

Subject Change: In three year degree course (B.A.) change of subjects is admissible in Ist year only. After admission one can change the subjects up to 31th October with a fee of Rs. 500/- per subject. After 31th October no change in subjects of students will be entertained.

Note: English medium students may select General English, Jainology, Science of Living and English Literature as their combination of subjects. Study material of these subjects are available in English.
